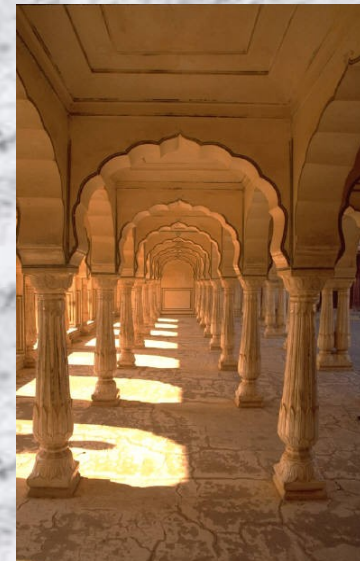

### Addiction in the Pews

Understanding the secret struggles of Addiction,  
and how to bring “Hope to the Hopeless”

Substance abuse is a subject that very few want to discuss within the church. Pastors very often feel ill equipped to deal with the issues of addiction. This is causing many individuals and families to turn to secular professionals and institutions to provide the help in the midst of their crisis. The church needs to be equipped to guide individuals on their journey to recovery and wholeness. The pressures of social acceptance that often lead to addiction are enticing and enslaving. Jesus said to his disciples, “you shall know the truth and the truth shall set you free” (John 8:32). That promise still holds for those with addiction issues. The church’s pastors need to be informed and equipped about addiction in order to minister to those in the pews with a message of HOPE and healing.

#### Course Objectives:

1. Gain a greater understanding of substance abuse.
2. Learn important information about the statistics of drug abuse.
3. Learn the major drugs of choice that are available, and their effects on the body and mind.
4. Provide means of pastoral intervention that can lead to HOPE for recovery.
