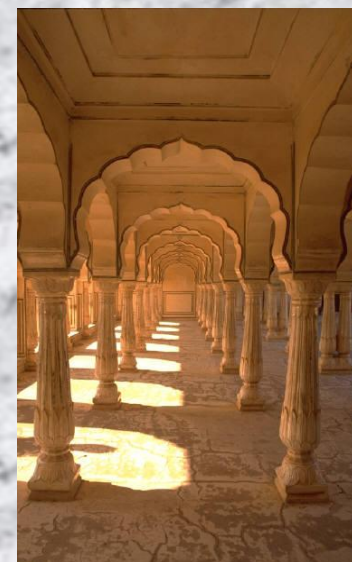

Instruction will be built on the foundation of Scripture. The Great Commission is used as a motivating call to make disciples of people in need. The participant will discover specific people helping skills to increase their ability to counsel others in need of assistance in dealing with life issues. How to be a People Helper, by Dr. Gary Collins will be used as a guide for the course. (available through Rhodes Grove with advanced payment of \$13.00)

Course Objectives:

1. Understand “people helping” in its broad sense.
2. Become better equipped in understanding the make-up of people and their life issues.
3. Increase sensitivity to the feelings, needs and pains of others.
4. Have a better ability to apply listening skills.
5. Develop direct ways to assist people with their personal life issues.
6. Learn to refer people who have life issues too difficult for the non-professional to handle.
7. Explore how Christian discipleship is the basis for a total “people helping” process.
8. Realize the significance of a growing commitment to Jesus Christ and Christian ministry.
