Leading Change: Challenges and Opportunities for the 21st Century Church

February 9, 2008

10:00 am-3:00 pm

This course will be led by Anthony Blair and Jo Ann Kunz. Anthony holds a Ph.D. in History and a D.Min. in Leadership in the Emerging Church. Jo Ann Kunz is co-Senior Pastor of Hosanna Christian Fellowship in Lititz, Pennsylvania, a congregation to which she has provided leadership since 1990. Tony joined Jo Ann in shared ministry at Hosanna in 2007. He is also Dean of Academic Affairs of the Campolo College of Eastern University and President of the Board of Directors of Rhodes Grove. Tony and Jo Ann see their role as that of “boundary leaders,” positioning the church in meaningful interaction with the wider world.

In this workshop, the facilitators will discuss six “directions” toward which a “missional” church must look in the twenty-first century (in, out, up, down, backward, and forward), identifying in each some of the major opportunities presented by the twenty-first century ministry context. They will also lead a discussion about change strategies, including Kotter’s eight-step approach to leading change and appreciative inquiry. By the conclusion of the workshop, participants will have completed a very basic environmental scan of their ministry context, identified one or more directions for further strategic thinking, and appropriated one or more strategies by which they can initiate and lead positive change.
